On the morning of 31st October 2021, we held our Annual Seerah Ijlas. In an environment alight with the Noor of our Beloved, we sat to reminisce His unparalleled life.



The program commenced with the recitation of the Quran. And indeed, what better way could we begin this blessed Majlis than with the description of our Habeeb ﷺ in the words of Allah ﷻ Himself:

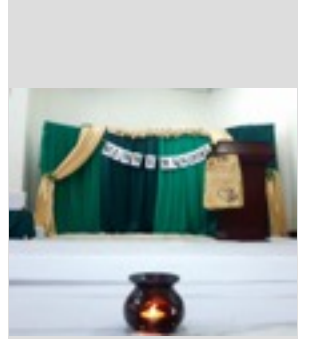
