The advent of a new year is very exciting.


There is something about the new year that causes one's spirits to be rejuvenated. The winds that bring about the new year smell of hope and aspirations. It is a rejuvenating feeling.

Muharram is derived from the root letters _haa raa_ and _meem_ (harama) and its meaning is to be forbidden or sacred.

This is because it is one of the 4 months in which Muslims are not allowed to initiate any form of warfare. The other 3 sacred months are Zul Qa'da, Zul Hijja and Rajab.

Rasulullah Sallallahu Alaihi Wasallam has also referred to Muharram as "the month of Allah".

A man came to the Prophet (Sallallahu Alaihi Wasallam) and said: "Which fasting is better after the month of Ramadan?" He said: "The month of Allah which is called Muharram." (Ibn Majah)

Taking into account the meaning of Muharram and the fact that it is also called the month of Allah, one can understand the importance and sacredness of this month.

A mu'min should therefore behave accordingly, more so in this month.

Due to the sacredness of certain months and days, the rewards for good deeds also increase. On the flip side, the magnanimity of sin also increases in these moments.

A mu'min should therefore make a very firm intention to stay away from all that is haraam and sinful and should make greater efforts to increase one's good deeds.
